

Predicting Response to Risperidone Treatment through Identification of Early-Onset of Antipsychotic Drug Action in Schizophrenia

Have you been diagnosed with schizophrenia and recently needed hospitalization, outpatient crisis management, or short-term treatment in an emergency room? If so, you might qualify to participate in a research study to see if the response to Risperdal® Risperidone at two weeks will show better improvement for the treatment of schizophrenia.

To be eligible, you must also:

- be between the ages of 19 and 65
- have needed more care in the last two weeks (i.e. crisis management, increased clinic visits, emergency room treatment, or hospitalization)
- be able to take study medication as directed
- be able to come to the Creighton University Psychiatry Research Center 9 times over a 13-week period
